



STEP ONE: SAND

Sand all of your wood surfaces and edges to get rid of any rough patches. ***You can either paint everything first, let it dry, and then build OR build first and paint after. Just make sure you can still find the nail holes!***



STEP TWO:

Apply GLUE to back of the small square piece. Place it on the bottom/center of the guitar base. Hammer two nails into the smaller pre-drilled holes.




STEP THREE:

Put a drop of glue in each of the larger holes on the small square piece. Hammer a wooden peg into each hole. *****Only hammer part way (about 1/4" deep) - do not over hammer or the peg will break!*****



STEP FOUR:

Put a drop of glue in each of the larger holes on the neck of the guitar (long rectangle). Hammer a wooden peg into each hole. *****Only hammer part way (about 1/4" deep) - do not over hammer or the peg will break!*****



STEP FIVE:

Apply glue to the back of the guitar neck where the two small holes are located. Attach the neck to the top center of the guitar by hammering two nails in to the pre-drilled holes.

STEP SIX: LIGHTNING BOLT & DECORATE!

Use glue and two SMALL NAILS provided to attach the lightning bolt anywhere you like. Use paint and rubber bands to finish your guitar.



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
